ABOUT THE REGION

Gothenburg is the second-largest city in Sweden. It is located on the west coast and has approximately 570,000 inhabitants in the proper town and about 1 million in the metropolitan area. You will find a vibrant cultural scene and a fascinating history accompanied by easy access to housing, safety, and healthcare.

ABOUT THE HOSPITAL

Sahlgrenska University Hospital is one of the country's leading university hospitals that provides everything from county healthcare to national highly specialised care.

Neuropsychiatry Clinic East is a subspecialized clinic for adult patients with ADHD, Autism, Tourette's syndrome and Intellectual disability with or without some psychiatric comorbidity.



Main responsibilities and expectations

- The unit is one of the largest sub-specialized Neuropsychiatric units in Sweden and provides care for approximately 3000 patients. The clinic employs more than 60 staff, including 13 specialist doctors and 4-5 junior doctors. The clinic has four teams, and each section has psychologists, nurses, an occupational therapist, a counsellor, a rehabilitation coordinator and a secretary. We work closely with nurses, and for each doctor's post, there is approximately one nurse.
- The department is constantly working on various improvement projects. It has received awards for some of these projects over the years. In addition, the unit is currently actively working on establishing an active research group with a focus on clinic-oriented research. The department is located very close to the centre of Gothenburg in a relatively newly built and nice facility where the employees' focus is to combine a good atmosphere and well-being with good and efficient work.
- You will participate in the Neuropsychiatric assessment process through the co-assessment model.
- You will collaborate with other staff to provide the patient with adequate psychosocial treatment.
- You will supervise resident doctors.

Salary and Conditions

- The unit is an outpatient clinic with opening hours 8-16, Monday-Friday.
- Flexible working hours based on your specific circumstances and needs, with some opportunity for teleworking.
