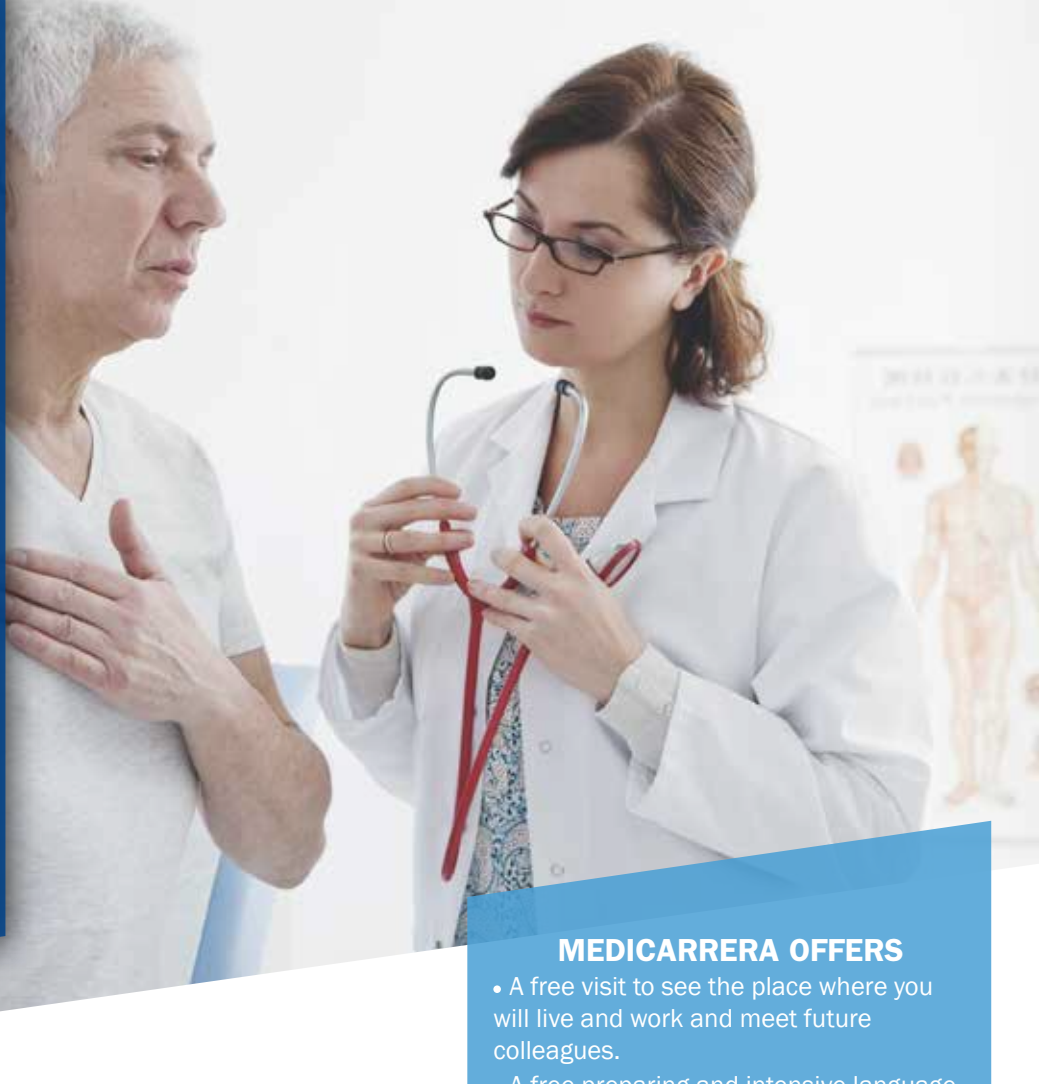

ABOUT THE HOSPITAL

Höglandssjukhuset in Eksjö is a modern emergency hospital and one of the largest county hospitals in Sweden.



Main expectations

- As a specialist / senior consultant at the medicine and geriatric clinic, you will vary your work between in and outpatient care. Together with other specialists, you will be responsible for in and outpatient pulmonology care.
- You will be responsible for hospitalized internal medicine patients.
- The clinic conducts extensive diagnostic activities with some emphasis on cancer.
- They also conduct advanced bronchoscopy operations with EBUS technology, which is currently performed at Ryhov County Hospital in Jönköping city, together with the hospital in Eksjö.
- All investigation and treatment of lung cancer within the Jönköping County Region occurs in close collaboration with the region where the lung section in Eksjö plays an important role.
- There are opportunities to work with inpatient and outpatient care with a broad spectrum of pulmonary medicine.

What's expected of you

- To be a specialist in pulmonology.
- The position includes caring for internal medicine patients as well, therefore the experience in internal medicine is an advantage.
- To be flexible, responsible and diligent.

Salary and Conditions

- First semester: Monthly gross salary of 51.500 SEK.
- After receiving the license to practice and ending the six-month trial period, the salary will be negotiated individually.
- Salary double specialist: minimum 70.000 SEK / month.
- Duties: 4-6 weekends per 3 month period.
