ABOUT THE REGION

Värmland Region is a county in west-central Sweden. It borders the Swedish counties of Dalarna, Örebro, and Västra Götaland, as well as the Norwegian counties of Viken and Innlandet to the west.

Region Värmland strengthens public health and develops healthcare to contribute to a world-class quality of life for Värmland's 290,000 inhabitants. They run health centers throughout Värmland and have three emergency hospitals: Arvika, Karlstad, and Torsby.

The healthcare facilities are knowledge-based, personalised, efficient and equitable. They provide person-centred care based on the needs of the individual patient. Care is provided close to the patient and on the patient's terms.

Main responsibilities and expectations

Requirements profile general radiologist:

- To be a general radiologist (Conventional radiology, CT, ultrasound, essential MRI preferred), some years of experience as a specialist- e.g. not worked for many years in only one examination method.
- To have experience with simple ultrasound interventions and fluoros-copy with nephrostomy insertions (preferably).
- To have the ability/willingness to go on-call/standby.
- To have social and collaborative skills.
- Solid and broad MR knowledge is a plus.

- To have some/few years of experience as a specialist in mammography.
- To have social and collaborative skills
